The deadline for donations is March 31st. Branches who meet the goal will be recognized at the AAUW Maryland Summer Conference.

AAUW Maryland decided to make this challenge to give Branch members a larger sense of belonging to AAUW beyond their Branch. By donating to the Women of Distinction Fund each member is participating in an Association and State AAUW Project. The Association project is the sponsorship of the National Conference for College Women Student Leaders (NCCWSL) which takes place in Washington, DC in early June. The State project is raising the sponsorship money of \$20,000 to honor our Maryland Woman of Distinction. If we make our \$20,000 goal (platinum sponsorship of Women of Distinction), Pat will be recognized at NCCWSL as the Maryland Woman of Distinction and will have the significant opportunity to address the conference attendees.
