### Preparing for the Unexpected

Join us for an engaging session on how to protect yourself and your household in the face of disasters and emergencies. A representative from the Howard County Office of Emergency Management will walk us through four essential steps of preparedness:

- Get Informed
- Write a Plan
- Build a Kit
- Be Involved

Whether you're just starting or looking to refine your emergency plans, this event will equip you with tools, templates, and knowledge to stay ready for the unexpected.

Our presenter, Lauren Chilton, has been serving as an emergency management specialist at the Howard County Office of Emergency Management since 2022, where she oversees the Hazard Mitigation and Outreach/Public Education programs. Prior to her work in Maryland, she worked as a Homeland Security Planner for the Brazos Valley Council of Governments in Bryan, Texas. She completed her bachelor's degree in Anthropology in 2017 and earned her Master of International Affairs in 2020 from Texas A&M University, specializing in National Security and Diplomacy.

The meeting will be held at the East Columbia Library, Lucille Clifton Room A-B. Light refreshments will be served. Non-perishable food will be collected here for the HC Food Bank.

# **DIVERSITY**
