The Fall Legislative Agenda Conference put on by the **Maryland Legislative Agenda for Women** was held November 23 at the Columbia Meeting House where there were about 170 attendees. Several of our Branch members attended as well as other AAUW members from Maryland. Among others, several state delegates, the Lieutenant Governor of Maryland--Aruna Miller, and Senator Chris Van Hollen addressed the group. Ariana Kelly was awarded the 2024 Legislative Leadership Award for her 14 years of work as both a delegate and a state senator championing dozens of bills to improve the lives of Maryland women and families. Fourteen legislative proposals were presented at the conference of which 6 to 8 will be selected by vote to present to next year's Maryland General Assembly.
