Education Committee Report

Several years ago, our branch established an AAUW – Howard County Branch Scholarship Fund within the Foundation. This year we funded scholarships for six students in the Parent Scholars Program. Branch fundraisers throughout the year provide the money for our scholarships.

- 2. You may make your donation <u>online</u>. This <u>link</u> will direct you to the Foundation's donation page. You will be asked to design your gift. Select "Other Designation" from the drop-down menu. Type "AAUW Howard County Branch Scholarship" in the space provided under the words "Other Designation". You will receive an acknowledgment and receipt directly from the Educational Foundation.
